Applications are invited for admission in Two years training programme under restructured pattern of craftsmen training scheme (Heat Engine Groups of Trades) starting from Sept, 2011. The training are imparted on modular pattern in different module of six weeks each; total eight modules of one year duration in the first year and two modules of six months each; total one year of two modules in second year of Auto or Diesel group. Exam is conducted at the end of first year and each modules of IInd year by NCVT and successful candidates awarded a NCVT certificates. 75 seats are available for the Session 2011-2012, however seats may be changed. The terms and conditions of admission as follows :-

1. **Age** : Between 14 to 40 years as on 01.09.2011.

2. **Qualifications** : Secondary pass from recognized board or equivalent with the subject Science or Maths, Physics and Chemistry.

OR

Secondary passed from recognized Board or equivalent under 10+2 scheme with the compulsory subjects as Science and Maths.

3. **Reservation** : As per rules of Central Govt.

4. **Scholarship stipend** : 25% trainees awarded stipend @Rs. 100/- per month on merit-cum-means.

5. **Training fees** : Rs. 100/- per month.

6. **Caution Money** : Rs. 250/- as Caution Money, refundable at the end of successful training.

7. **Hostel facilities** : Not available.

8. **Others** : Admission will be on the basis of merit of Secondary Examination.

9. **How to apply** : Application form may be obtained from the office of the MITI Jodhpur at cost Rs.25/- in cash OR by post on payment of Indian Postal Order of Rs. 35/- in the name of Principal, MITI, Jodhpur (Rajasthan) & one envelope 10x23 self-addressed.
