MPhil in *Applied Economics* and PhD in *Economics*

Full-time residential programmes affiliated to JNU commencing on August 01, 2011.

★ MPhil Programme in *Applied Economics*

Eligibility:

Master's in *Economics*/ other *Social Sciences*/ *Humanities*/ *Law* with $\geq 55\%$ marks
or with $\geq 60\%$ in *Sciences*/ *Technology* / *Life Sciences*

- Statutory reservation for SC, ST, PH ($\geq 40\%$ disability) and OBC (NCL) candidates.
- Journalists and Post-graduates in Journalism can seek the JET fellowship to undergo the coursework or the full Programme
- MPhil students can seek provisional enrolment for PhD subject to conditions.

★ PhD Programme in *Economics*

The priority areas, based on current faculty research interests, are: *Agriculture*; *Economic History*; *Gender & Development*; *Health*; *Poverty*; *Industry & Technology*; *Labour & Employment*; *Population Studies*; *Trade and Macroeconomics*.

Eligibility: MPhil with FGPA of at least 6.0 (*high second class*) and
Master's with $\geq 55\%$ marks in *Economics* or related disciplines.

CDS envisages an intake of 12 for the MPhil and 6 for the PhD Programme

- Those awaiting results of the qualifying examination can also apply.
- SC, ST & PH ($\geq 40\%$ disability) candidates are eligible irrespective of percentage of marks in the qualifying degree.

Selection is based on *Academic Record* and *Research Aptitude*. Shortlisted candidates shall undergo written test & interview at CDS. PhD admission will also depend upon whether the proposed study can be undertaken at CDS.

Financial assistance @ Rs. 3000 per month for MPhil and @ Rs. 12,000 per month for PhD. UGC JRF/ SRF & RGNF can be availed of for both Programmes. University/ College Teachers can opt for ICSSR's two-year salary protected scheme for PhD.
