## Common Entrance Test (CET-LL.M) 2011

The School of Legal Studies, Indian Maritime University (IMU) will conduct the Common Entrance Test (CET, LL.M) on June 19, 2011 at Bangalore, Chennai, Cochin, Hyderabad, Kolkata, Mumbai, New Delhi, and Pune. IMU-CET (LL.M) is a perquisite for admission to the LL.M Programme in Maritime Law that will be offered at the Chennai and Cochin campuses from the August 2011 session. The LL.M is a two-year Masters programme in Maritime Law that aims to provide a thorough grounding all aspects of International Maritime Law. The curriculum includes specialized courses in Shipping Law and the Law of the Sea. The programme aims to equip lawyers with the knowledge and skills required to make a valuable contribution to the International Shipping Industry. IMU has signed an MoU with the National Law School of India University, Bangalore and offers a seminar course on the Law of the Sea there.

## IMU-CET (LL.M) Eligibility

The candidate must hold a Bachelor's degree in Law with at least 55% marks or equivalent CGPA {50% in case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC) Scheduled Tribe (ST) and Differently Abled (DA) categories} awarded by any of the Universities incorporated by an Act of the Central or State legislature in India. Candidates appearing for the final year of the Bachelor's degree/equivalent qualification examination and those who have completed degree requirement and are awaiting results can also apply. Prospective candidates must maintain a valid email account throughout the selection process.

IMU-CET (LL.M) Application Form will be made available through the following channels :

- v Downloading the application form, information brochure and challan through <u>www.imu.tn.nic.in</u> and paying the relevant fee through challan to any of SBI/Indian Bank branches throughout India.
