(c) <u>Interview - 20 Marks:-</u>The Candidates, who obtain the prescribed passing marks in written examination, will be called for Interview to check personal bearing, response, aptitude, general level of intelligence etc.

(d) **Detailed Medical Examination**:

Candidates shortlisted **in order of merit** will be put through a Detailed Medical Examination to assess their fitness.

11- Appeal in case of rejection in detailed medical examination:-

The appeal should be submitted within 30 days from the date of issue of the Rejection Slip (in which the findings of the Medical Officer are communicated to the candidate) to The Inspector General (Northern) Frontier, ITBP, Post Office -Seemadwar, Distt- Dehradun (UKD) - 248146.
