RECRUITMENT OF INSPECTOR (HINDI TRANSLATOR)

Applications are invited from Indian citizens for filling up the following vacancies for the year 2011 on temporary basis likely to be permanent for the post of Inspector (Hindi Translator) Group ‘B’ in Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force. The posts have all India liability and selected candidates can be posted anywhere in India and even abroad. The selected candidates will have to complete the prescribed basic training successfully. On appointment, the candidate shall be governed by the ITBPF Act and Rules.

2. Last date for receipt of applications is 23rd May, 2011 for all States except for Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu & Kashmir State, Lahaul and Spiti District and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, the Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep for which last date is 30th May, 2011.

3. **PAY SCALE AND OTHER ALLOWANCES: -**

- a) Pay Scale – Pay Band 2, Rs. 9300 – 34800 + Grade Pay of Rs. 4600.
- b) Other allowances: The post will carry Dearness Allowance, Ration Money, Washing Allowance as admissible from time to time, Special Compensatory Allowance while posted in specified border areas, free uniform, free accommodation or HRA, Transport Allowance, Free leave pass and any other allowance as admissible in the Force from time to time under the rules/instructions. These posts will be covered under new Restructured Defined contribution Pension scheme.

4. A candidate appearing for the test should mention/intimate if any criminal case(s) is/are pending/lodged against him in any police station/Hon’ble court.

6. **ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:**

- (i) **AGE:** – 30 Years. Cutoff date for determining the age will be – **23rd May, 2011**

Note:-

- (a) Upper age limit is relaxable for SC/ST by 5 years and for OBC by 3 years.
- (b) The upper age limit shall be relaxed by the length of military service increased by 3 years in case of Ex-servicemen.
- (c) Upper age limit is relaxable upto 5 years to the children and dependent family members of those killed in 1984 riots and riots of 2002 in Gujarat. SC/ST/OBC relaxation as per Govt. instructions will be in addition. Children and dependent family members should produce a Certificate to that effect from the Collector of the concerned District where the victim was killed.
- (d) Upper age limit is relaxable upto 5 years to all persons who had ordinarily been domiciled in the State of Jammu & Kashmir during the period from 1st day of January 1980 to the 31st day of December 1989.
- (e) Upper age limit is relaxable upto 5 years for Govt. servant in accordance with the instructions issued by the Central Govt. Persons serving in Govt./semi Govt. department may send their applications through proper channel alongwith “No Objection Certificate” as per format in **Annexure-I**.

- (ii) **EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:** –

Master’s Degree from a recognised university in Hindi or English with Hindi and English as compulsory or elective subjects or as the medium of examination at the degree level.

OR

Master’s Degree from a recognised university in any subject other than Hindi and English with Hindi and English as compulsory or elective subjects or either of the two as the medium of examination and the other as a compulsory or elective subject at the degree level.

OR

Master’s Degree from a recognised university in any subject other than Hindi and English with Hindi or English as the medium of examination and English or Hindi as a compulsory or elective subjects or as medium of examination at the degree level.

OR

(iv) **MEDICAL STANDARDS:-**

- (a) **Eye Sight:** Should be medically fit in all respects (Eye sight 6/6 and 6/9 of two eyes without correction i.e. without wearing glasses).
- (b) Candidates must not suffer from knock-knee, flat foot, varicose veins or squint in the eyes and should possess high colour vision. They must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of duties.

7. **HOW TO APPLY AND BY WHICH DATE:-**

Eligible and interested candidates should send their Applications and related Annexures (duly filled in Hindi or English only) complete in all respects in the prescribed proforma as per **Annexure 'I' to 'V'**, either type written or neatly hand written on one side only on full size plain paper with passport size photographs affixed on application/admit card (duly attested by a Gazetted Officer) along with **application fee**, enclosures as in **para-9** to The **INSPECTOR GENERAL (NORTHERN) FRONTIER, ITBP, POST OFFICE- SEEMADWAR, DISTT.- DEHRADUN (UKD) – 248146**. The duly filled application must reach on or before the prescribed last date i.e. **23rd May, 2011** for all States except for Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu & Kashmir State, Lahaul and Spiti District and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, the Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep for which last date is **30th May, 2011**.

8. **APPLICATION FEE:** Application Fee will be Rs. 50/- for candidates belonging to General and OBC category only and no fee will be charged from SC/ST and Ex-Servicemen candidates. The candidates should attach the Indian Postal Order/Central Recruitment Fee Stamps (CRFS) or Crossed Bank Draft drawn in the name of **INSPECTOR GENERAL (NORTHERN) FRONTIER, ITBP, "PAYABLE AT SBI IMA DEHRADUN, CODE NO 0739**. The candidates paying application fee by CRFS must affix the duly cancelled CRF Stamps at the specified space on the application form.

9. **ENCLOSURES REQUIRED TO BE ATTACHED WITH APPLICATION:-**

- e) Discharge Certificate for Ex-Servicemen.
- f) Two latest passport size photographs. (one pasted on application form and another on admit card duly attested)
- g) IPO/Bank Draft/CRFS of Rs.50/- (for General and OBC Candidates only).
- h) One self addressed envelope of 4”X9” size with Rs. 5/- postage stamp affixed on the envelope.
- j) Envelope containing Application must be superscribed in bold letters “APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF INSPECTOR (HINDI TRANSLATOR) IN ITBP”

Note: All the above relevant original documents/certificates are required to be brought at the time of recruitment test.

10. **SELECTION PROCESS:**

The candidates whose applications are found to be in order shall be issued Admit Cards to appear in recruitment test. The date and place of recruitment test will be indicated in Admit card. Candidates will have to undergo the following tests:

- a) **Physical Measurement:** Candidates who are found eligible on verification of documents will be screened **first for Height, Chest (for male candidates only) and Weight measurements.**

Note:- Those who do not qualify the Physical Measurement Tests will get eliminated from the process there only and will not be allowed to appear in further tests.

- (b) **Written Examination – 200 Marks (100 Marks each paper)**

The PET qualified candidates will be required to pass the following examination with at least 50% marks in each written paper (excluding Interview) and 55% marks in aggregate (including Interview). The SC/ST candidates will be given concession upto 5% marks as per Govt. of India instructions on the subject contained in DOP&T OM No. 36012/23/96-Estt.(Res.) Vol.II dated 03.10.2000.

- (c) **Interview - 20 Marks:-**The Candidates, who obtain the prescribed passing marks in written examination, will be called for Interview to check personal bearing, response, aptitude, general level of intelligence etc.
- (d) **Detailed Medical Examination:**
Candidates shortlisted **in order of merit** will be put through a Detailed Medical Examination to assess their fitness.

11- **Appeal in case of rejection in detailed medical examination:-**

- i) A candidate declared unfit in detail medical examination, if not satisfied with the findings of the Medical Officer, can submit an appeal for his re-medical examination alongwith a Medical Fitness Certificate as per **Annexure-“VI”**, as a piece of evidence about the possibility of an error of judgment in the decision of the Medical Officer. The medical certificate will not be taken into consideration unless it contains a note by the medical practitioner concerned to the effect that it has been given in full knowledge of the fact that the candidate has already been rejected as unfit for appointment by a Medical Officer. The appeal will also not be taken into consideration unless it contains Medical Re-examination fee of Rs. 25/- through Indian Postal Order or Demand Draft in the name of Commandant, Base Hospital, ITBP, New Delhi and rejection slip (in original) issued by the Presiding Officer. The appeal should be submitted within 30 days from the date of issue of the Rejection Slip (in which the findings of the Medical Officer are communicated to the candidate) to The **Inspector General (Northern) Frontier, ITBP, Post Office – Seemadwar, Distt- Dehradun (UKD) – 248146**. The appeals received after the prescribed 30 days, without relevant documents will not be entertained. ITBP will not be responsible for any kind of postal delay etc.
- ii) The decision of the Re-Medical Board of ITBP shall be final and no second appeal will be entertained as per Govt. instructions and also no reply of the correspondence/second appeal will be given/entertained.
12. All eligible candidates will be duly informed about the date and venue of the recruitment tests through admit card. Candidates should come duly prepared for 6-7 days stay under their own arrangements at the Recruitment Centre. Under any circumstances, the Government shall not be responsible for loss/damage/injury, if any, to the individual sustained during the recruitment tests. **No TA/DA will be admissible. Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected and no correspondence on this will be entertained. No application after the last date as mentioned above will be accepted.**
