(ii) Twelve Years' professional experience in generation, transmission or distribution of Electricity or maintenance of electrical equipment (including at least three years' experience in electrical engineering in direct relation to plant and equipment used in mining).

Note 1: Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission in case of candidates otherwise well qualified.

Note 2 : The qualification regarding experience is relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes if, at any Stage of selection, the Union Public Service Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.

- 1. (The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationist shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion. The period of deputation/contract including the period of deputation/contract in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed five years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (including short-term contract) shall not be exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.)
- 2. The vacancies are in the Directorate General of Mines Safety (DGMS), Dhanbad but the selected candidates are liable to be transferred to anywhere in India.

- (v) To inspect the workshops of approved manufacturers of checking the testing facilities and quality control arrangement and such other works assign to him by the Director General or Deputy Director General.
- 4. The Officer selected will have the option to draw his grade pay plus deputation (duty) allowance in accordance with the Department of Personnel and Training O.M. No. 2/12/87-Estt. (pay-II) dated 29/04/1988 as amended from time to time or to have his pay fixed in the scale of pay of the post subject to restrictions contained in the Department of Personnel and Training O.M. No. 2/8/97-Estt. (pay-II) dated 11/03/1988 as amended from time to time.
- 5. With a view to facilitate scrutiny about eligibility, the candidates from Public Sector Undertakings should clearly indicate whether the pay scale held by them is on the Central D.A. Pattern or the Industrial D.A. Pattern.
