IIG operates the EQUATORIAL GEOPHYSICAL RESEARCH LABORATORY (EGRL), one of its regional centres located near

Tirunelveli (Tamil Nadu). The institute offers research oriented programmes for post-graduate students at this centre (EGRL) leading to Ph.D. degree.

SCHOLARSHIP: Rs. 12000/- per month (consolidated) for first and second years and Rs. 14000/- per month in subsequent years. Those candidates who have CSIR-UGC-JRF (NET) qualification are eligible for scholarships of Rs. 16000/- (first and second years) and Rs. 18000/- (during subsequent years). In addition, a book grant

of Rs. 6000/- per annum is provided to the students during the second and subsequent years. **REQUIREMENTS:** M.Sc. in Physics with a minimum of 60% marks. Candidates who are appearing in the final

year examination may also apply. MAXIMUM AGE: 28 years SELECTION CRITERIA: Candidates who have cleared either the GATE or the CSIR-UGC-JRF (NET) examination

in Physical Sciences will be called for the interview. For others, a separate written examination will be conducted by the centre followed by the interview.
