Admission Notice For Craft Instructor Training Courses

Applications are invited for admissions to "CRAFT INSTRUCTOR TRAINING COURSES" in Advanced Training Institute, Kanpur for the session 2011-2012 commencing from **1st August 2011.** The training will be imparted in the following trades:

Engineering Trades:

1. Electrician 2. Wireman 3. Electronic Mechanic 4. Mechanic Motor Vehicle 5. Fitter 6. Turner 7. Welder 8. Machinist Non Engineering Trades:

1. Cutting & Sewing

Training in all the trades will be provided on Modular Pattern of four modules each of 3 months duration for Engineering Trades and of three modules each module of 4 months duration for Non-Engineering Trades starting from **August 2011**. These modules are spread over a year from August to October, November to January, February to April and May to July for Engineering Trades and from August to November, December to March, April to July for Non-Engineering Trades. However, a trainee once admitted has the option to complete all the modules in a span of 3 years in any of Advanced Training Institutes of DGE&T.

Modules for Engineering Trades:

1. Trade Technology-I

2. Trade Technology-II

3. Engineering Technology

4. Training Methodology and Soft Skill

Modules For Non-Engineering Trades:

1. Trade Skill-I

2. Trade Skill-II

3. Training Methodology

Training Objective and Certificate:

These courses will cover comprehensive training in skill development and Training Methodology including Principles of Teaching so as to make the trainees qualified trained Instructors for Industrial Training Institutes/Industrial Training Centres and industry. Successful trainees on completion of all the prescribed modules of a trade will be awarded certificates by NCVT, Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India. However, Marks Sheet after completion of each module will be issued by the institute.

Eligibility:

National Trade Certificate or National Apprenticeship Certificate in relevant trade or Diploma in relevant branch of Engineering.

Age:

Between 18 to 40 years, upper age relaxable by 5 years for SC/ST candidates. No age bar for

sponsored candidates.

Selection:

Eligible sponsored candidates will be admitted directly. In case the number of nominations of sponsored candidates is more than the number of seats available in a trade, the institute may conduct an Admission-cum-Aptitude test for shortlisting of the candidates.

Selection of private candidates will be made on merit basis only.

Preference of admission will be given in the following order:

1. Candidates sponsored by the Directorate of States/Union Territories ,In-charge of Craftsmen Training and Establishments implementing Apprentices Act, 1961 through their BTCs, will be given first preference.

2. Second preference will be given to the candidates sponsored by the affiliated ITCs(for the Candidates of the affiliated trades only), Government of India Departments, any other Department of State Government/UT, Public Sector Enterprises (Central/State), Industrial Organisations.

3. Third preference will be given to the candidates who have completed three/two/one modules in that order. In case, the number of applications of the candidates who have completed same number of modules exceed the number of seats available, then the admission will be given on the basis of merit.

4. Remaining vacant seats, if any, will be filled-up from Private candidates on the basis of merit

only.

Reservation:

Seats are reserved for Private candidates in various categories as per rules of Govt. of India.

1. Directorate of States/Union Territories, In-charge of Craftsmen Training and Establishments implementing Apprentices Act, 1961 through their BTCs may send nominations of their instructors directly to the Director of the Institute.

2. Affiliated ITCs, Government of India Departments, Departments of State Government/UT, Public Sector Enterprises (Central/State), Industrial Organisations must nominate their Instructors in the prescribed Nomination Form of the institute.

3. Candidates who have completed three/two/one modules may apply in the prescribed Re-

Admission Form of the institute.

 Private candidates seeking admission may apply in the prescribed Admission Form of the Institute.
Admission Form/Nomination Form/Re-Admission Form may be obtained from the Institute counter. Outstation applicants may get the forms by post directly by sending request to the Director of the Institute on payment of Rs. 100/-(Admission Form and Registration fee) at this Institute along with a Postal Order/Demand Draft of Rs. 100/- in favour of DDO, ATI, Kanpur and a self-addressed stamped envelope (size: 11cm x 25cm) of Rs. 5.00.
