Applications are invited from Indian Nationals for the Award of **six** Fellowships for Doctoral work in Criminology and Police Science for three years.

ELIGIBILITY :

1. First or second class Master's Degree not less than 55% marks for General Category and 50% for Reserve Category (SC/ST/OBC) in Criminology, Sociology, Social work, Psychology, Social Anthropology, Public Administration, Political Science, Law and Police Administration.
2. Preference to the NET/SET qualified candidate.
3. **Registered** for Ph.D. programme with any recognized Indian university.
4. **The fellowships are open to Indian National of 30 years of age in General Category and 35 years of age in Reserve Category (SC/ST/OBC) as on the date of publication of Advertisement for the purpose every year.**
5. **Reservation : SC/ST/OBC as per Government of India rules.**
