RECRUITMENT FOR THE POST OF CONSTABLE (ANIMAL TRANSPORT)

Applications are invited from **male Indian citizens** for filling up the following vacancies on temporary basis likely to be permanent, for the post of **Constables (Animal Transport)** in the Indo Tibetan Border Police Force. The post has All India liability and selected candidates can be posted anywhere in India and even abroad. On appointment, the candidate shall be governed by the ITBPF Act and Rules. The last date of receipt of application is **23.06.2011** for all States except for Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir state, Lahaul-Spiti District and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands and the Union Territory of Lakshadweep for which last date is **30.06.2011**.

2. **PAY SCALE AND OTHER ALLOWANCES: -**

- a) PB-I, Pay Scale- Rs. 5200 – 20,200 + Grade Pay Rs. 2,000/- per month.
- b) **Other allowances:** The post will carry Dearness Allowance, Ration Money, Washing Allowance as admissible from time to time, Special Compensatory Allowance while posted in specified border areas, free uniform, free accommodation or HRA, Transport Allowance, Free leave pass and any other allowance as admissible in the Force from time to time under the rules/instructions. **These posts will be covered under Restructured Defined Contribution Pension Scheme.**

3. A candidate appearing for the test should mention/intimate if any criminal case(s) is/are pending/lodged against him in any police station/Hon'ble court.

Note: - 10% of the vacancies in each category are reserved for Ex-Servicemen.

5. **ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:**

- (i) **AGE:** – Between 18 to 25 Years (**Cut off date for determining the age will be – 23.06.2011**)

Note:-

(a) Upper age limit is relaxable for SC/ST by 5 years and for OBC by 3 years.

(b) The upper age limit shall be relaxed by the length of military service increased by 3 years in case of Ex-servicemen.

- (c) Upper age limit is relaxable upto 5 years to the children and dependent family members of those killed in 1984 riots and riots of 2002 in Gujarat. SC/ST/OBC relaxation as per Govt. instructions will be in addition. Children and dependent family members should produce a certificate to that effect from the Collector of the concerned District where the victim was killed.
- (d) Upper age limit is relaxable upto 5 years to all persons who had ordinarily been domiciled in the State of Jammu & Kashmir during the period from 01st day of January 1980 to 31st day of December 1989.
- (e) Upper age limit is relaxable upto 5 years for Govt. servant in accordance with the instructions issued by the Central Govt. Persons serving in Govt./semi Govt. Department may send their applications through proper channel alongwith “No Objection Certificate” as per format in Annexure-I.

(ii) **EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:**

- a) Matriculation or equivalent from recognized board.
- b) 8th class pass from a recognized Institution for S.T. Category candidates belonging to Mizoram State.

(iv) **Medical Standards:-**

- a) **Vision:** Minimum distant vision should 6/6 and 6/9 of both eyes without correction (i.e. without wearing glasses).
- (b) Candidates must not suffer from knock knees, flat foot, varicose veins or squint in eyes and should possess high colour vision. They must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.

6. **HOW TO APPLY AND BY WHICH DATE:-**

Eligible and interested candidates should send their Applications (duly filled in Hindi or English only) complete in all respects and Candidate's Admit Card duly filled in, in the prescribed proforma as per **Annexure 'I'** and **Annexure 'II'**. The application should either be type written or neatly hand written on one side only on full size plain paper with passport size photographs affixed & duly attested by Gazetted Officer along with **application fee**, attested copies of the testimonials as in **para-8** to the "**Inspector General (North West) Frontier, ITBP, PO-Seema Nagar, (Near Airport) Chandigarh (UT) -160003**", on or before the prescribed last date i.e. **23.06.2011** for all States except for Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir State, Lahaul-Spiti District and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba District of HP, Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep for which last date is **30.06.2011**.

7. **APPLICATION FEE:** The candidates belonging to General and OBC category will be required to pay Rs. 50/- (Non refundable) as application fee in form of **Central Recruitment Fee Stamp(CRFS)/IPO/ Bank Draft** in favour of "**Inspector General (North West) Frontier, ITBP, PO-Seema Nagar, Chandigarh(UT) PAYABLE AT SBI, AFS Chandigarh, Code No- 1495**". The candidates opting for CRFS should affix the CRFS at specified space in application form and get cancelled as well.

- (vi) Two latest passport size photographs. (one pasted on application form and another on admit card duly attested)
- (vii) IPO/Bank Draft of Rs.50/- **(for General and OBC Candidates only)**.
- (viii) Two self addressed envelopes of 4"X9" size with Rs. 5/- postage stamps affixed on each envelope.
- (ix) Certificate as per Annexure 'V' for claiming relaxation in height & chest (if applicable)
- (x) Envelope containing Application must be superscribed in bold letters "**APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF CONSTABLE (AT) IN ITBP**".

Note:- All the above original documents/certificates are required to be brought at the time of recruitment tests for verification by the Board.

9. **SELECTION PROCESS:** The eligible candidates shall be issued Admit cards to appear in recruitment test. The date and place of recruitment test will be indicated in Admit card. The candidates will have to undergo the following recruitment tests:-

(a) **Height Bar** – At the very beginning of recruitment process, candidates will be asked to go through the height bar test. The candidates not meeting the prescribed height will be eliminated.

(b) **Race** - The candidates, who qualify the Height Bar Test, will be subjected to 5Km race to be completed within 24 minutes to qualify for further tests. No marks will be awarded for this test and it will be only qualifying in nature.

(c) **Checking of documents**: The documents of candidates will be checked by the board. Original documents will be returned on the spot after verification and photocopies will be retained with the application form. Those who clear this stage will go to PST.

(d) **Physical Standard Test (PST)**: Candidates found eligible in documentation will be screened for height, chest and weight measurements by the board. Those who do not meet the required physical measurements will be eliminated at this stage.

(e) **Physical Efficiency Test (PET)** : The candidates who clear the PST event will be required to undergo PET which will consist of the following:-

Long Jump	11 feet	(03 chances to be given)
High Jump	3-1/2 feet	(03 chances to be given)

Note - Physical Efficiency Test (PET) will be qualifying in nature and it will not carry any marks. Those who do not qualify in any of PET events will be discarded then and there and will not be allowed to appear in further events. **No Race or Physical Efficiency Test (PET) will be held for Ex-servicemen.** However, Ex-servicemen will be required to pass the requisite PST, written examination and medical examination.

(f) **Written Examination (100 Marks)**: The candidates qualified in RACE, PST and PET will be required to pass the written examination consisting of following:-

General English (objective type)	20 questions	20 Marks
General Hindi (objective type)	20 questions	20 Marks
General Awareness (objective type/bilingual)	20 questions	20 Marks
Quantitative Aptitude Test (objective type/bilingual)	20 questions	20 Marks

Note: Qualifying marks shall be 35% for General Candidates & Ex-Servicemen and 33% for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes /Other Backward Class in the Written Examination

- i) The duration of the Written Examination will be 2 hours.
- ii) Candidates will be required to answer in OMR sheet, which will be signed both by the candidate and invigilator.
- iii) The candidates will be allowed to take carbon copy of the answer sheet. Answer key to the question paper will be posted on the website and displayed on the notice board after the written examination is completed.

iv) The OMR answer sheet of written test will be processed/scanned in an electronic machine. Any wrong entry of roll number, name, question booklet number, question paper series etc will render the OMR sheet invalid and the same will not be evaluated. The concerned candidates will be responsible for such mistake on their part.

(g) **Interview:** There will be no interview for this recruitment.

(h) **Merit List** – Merit lists in each category namely, Gen, SC, ST, OBC and Ex-servicemen will be drawn on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in the written examination. The candidates shall be called for Detailed Medical Examination (DME) as per the category-wise vacancies and strictly on the basis of this merit.

(j) **Detailed Medical Examination (DME):** Candidates selected in order of merit will be put through medical examination to assess their fitness as per the medical standards fixed for the post.

(k) **Appeal against medical examination:**

i) A candidate declared unfit in detailed medical examination, if not satisfied with the findings of the Medical Officer, can submit an **appeal for his re-medical examination with a duly filled Medical certificate as per Form No. 6 (at Annexure-VI) as a proof of evidence about the error of judgment on the part of Recruitment Medical Officer.**

ii) The medical certificate will not be taken into consideration unless it contains a note by the medical practitioner concerned to the effect that it has been given in full knowledge of the fact that the candidate has already been rejected as unfit for appointment in ITBP by a Medical Officer.

iii) The appeal will also not be taken into consideration unless it contains Medical Re-Examination Fee of Rs. 25/- in form of Indian Postal Order or Demand Draft in the name of **Commandant, Base Hospital, ITB Police, New Delhi and Rejection Slip (in original)** issued by the Presiding Officer.

iv) The appeal complete in all respect should be submitted within 15 days from the date of issue of the communication i.e. Rejection Slip, **(ITBP will not be responsible for any postal delay)** to the Nodal Officer i.e. the authority to whom the initial application was submitted. The appeals received after the prescribed 15 days, without relevant documents will not be entertained.

v) The decision of the re-medical board of ITBP shall be final and no 2nd appeal will be entertained as per Govt. instructions and also no reply of the correspondence/2nd appeal will be given/ entertained.

10. Candidates who are already in Central/State Govt. service including Departmental Candidates send their application through proper channel with NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE from their Employer. Application received without proper channel and NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE will also be rejected.

11. All eligible candidates will be duly informed about the date and venue of the recruitment tests through admit card. Candidates should come duly prepared for 2-3 or more days stay under their own arrangements at the Recruitment Centre. The Government shall not be responsible for damage/injury, if any, to the individual sustained during the selection test/recruitment process. **No TA/DA will be admissible. Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected and no correspondence on this will be entertained. No application after the last date as mentioned above will be accepted.**
