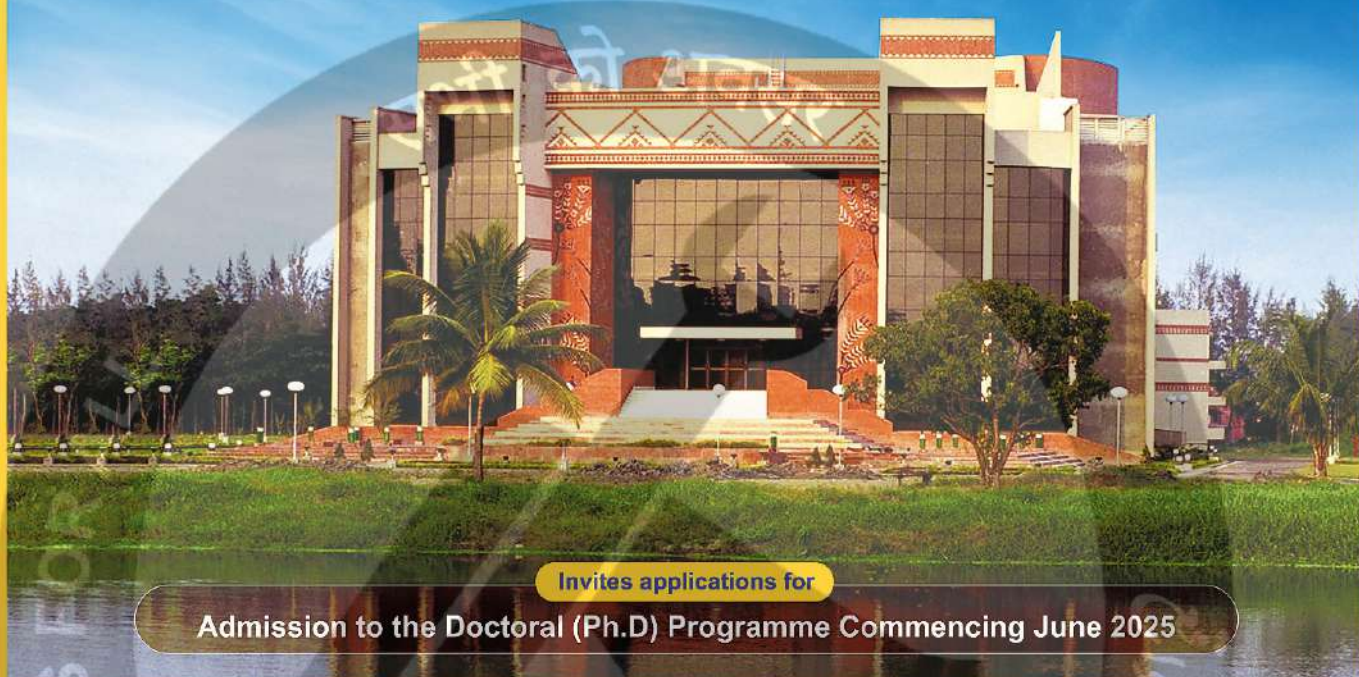

Admission to the Doctoral (Ph.D) Programme Commencing June 2025

Applicant must have either a First Class Master's or Post graduate diploma (2 years) in any discipline and a three-year Bachelor's degree with at least 50% marks in the aggregate; OR, CA with minimum 50% marks or CS/CMA with minimum 55% marks, with B.com degree; OR, B.Tech/4 year's degree with 6.5 CGPA or equivalent. In addition, applicant must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate in either the Secondary or the Higher Secondary Examination of a Board (or equivalent). Applicant can apply to at most two "areas of specialization". Applicant is required to have taken the Common Admission Test (CAT) in 2024 OR, depending on chosen specialization(s), alternative test(s) in lieu of the CAT as specified below. The test score(s) should be valid on January 30th, 2025.

*Validity of score (other than CAT) - Two years from the date of the test and should be valid on the deadline of submission of the application form.

#Online GMAT/GRE (Take home) exam scores are not valid. Only test center-based GMAT/GRE scores are valid. Candidates should get their GMAT scores officially reported to the Institute using the code: 9CP-HT-94, and GRE scores officially reported to the Institute using the code: 7496.

Financial Support: Stipend, student development support, computer grant, support for field research, teaching assistantship in the research phase, support to attend international conference/workshop.

Reservation: Government of India guidelines for reservation are followed during admissions.

How to Apply: A candidate can apply to a maximum of two areas of specialization. The SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PWD applicant (submitting attested copy of SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PWD certificate) are required to pay application fee of Rs. 1000/-, and all other applicants are required to pay an application fee of Rs. 2000/-.
